POSITIONS (and very basic descriptions)

Discipleship Leader (Coordinator)- The staff member who speaks at every chapel. This position has the privilege of creating the curriculum that will be delivered all summer to the campers and staff.

Leadership Development Coordinator - The two (one of each gender) who develop a curriculum and then lead and supervise the high school "junior counselors" in what it means to be a Christian leader.

Service Development Coordinator - The one who develops and teaches a curriculum of what it means to be a servant leader to the high school service participants. They also lead them in service projects around camp.

Recreation Coordinator - The one who helps plan activities and games prior to camp. They are the one during camp who is up front directing the crowd on what is happening next.

Worship Coordinator - The one who plans and leads Chapel music with the help of their trusty bandmates.

Camp Counselor - The crew who spends their weeks pouring into, loving, leading devotions, and laughing with a group of 7-9 campers.

Lifeguard/Dishwasher - The team of three who save lives every afternoon and are responsible for cleaning up the kitchen after every meal.

Photographer - The one who takes pictures and videos and uses them to create awesome DVD's to send home with every camper.

Kitchen Staff - The crew who keeps everyone happy by preparing all of the food and beverages.

Health Room - The one who makes sure all of the campers receive their correct medication and that all other health concerns are taken care of.

Maintenance - The crew that fixes things, lights bonfires, mows, and assists with set up and take down.

Office Intern - The intern who provides assistance and office support to the Assistant Camp Director.
