Worship Music Coordinator Description Detail

The Worship Music Coordinator will work with the discipleship coordinator and camp administration to plan all camp music and to make sure all worship services flow in such a way to create the best worship experience possible for camp and staff. The primary responsibility will be to put together a worship band, lead them to know and understand how to lead worship, and to lead the campers and staff in worship each chapel and vespers. The secondary responsibility is to give the staff excellent worship opportunities during staff training and at times when the campers are not present. It is also a responsibility to work with all of the campers and staff in such a way to allow Christian community to develop.

This position is accountable to Diane and Brian.

The Worship Music Coordinator does not directly supervise any other staff.

The Worship Music Coordinator shall perform all these duties related to the position as assigned by Diane or Brian, including (but not limited to):

- 1. To guard the hearts of all of the staff with no exceptions by seeking to find and emphasis everyone's strengths without drawing attention to their faults.
- 2. To serve as a mature Christian example for the campers and fellow staff.
- 3. To take responsibility for all music at camp by arriving at camp prepared with songs for multiple ages ready to make set lists.
- 4.To think before acting and make wise decisions.
- 5. To participate 100% with encouragement and Christian sportsmanship in all activities.
- 6. To Participate 100% in chapel and all small group and devotional activities.
- 7. To be on time to all activities.
- 8. To pay attention during staff meetings so individual instruction will be unnecessary.
- 9. To show attention and affection to all campers regardless of their actions.
- 10. All songs/music used during camp should positively reflect Christian values and be age appropriate.
- 11. To work with cabins as they plan for vespers services and make sure song books are available at all times needed.
- 12. To have easy worship presentations and music for each band members ready in advance of each chapel.
- 13. To keep track of all music equipment and notify camp office or any missing or damaged equipment promptly.
- 14. To clean your own cabin and participate fully in the cleaning of the rest of the camp while paying special attention to cleaning up after yourself and showing respect to the work of others.
- 15. To be willing to do any task assigned by camp management.
